RESEARCH POSTER COMPETITION

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Participants may submit more than one abstract.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Studies conducted in Ministry Of Health facilities must submit NMRR ID with their abstract (CRC will guide through the NMRR registration).
- All types of research will be considered, including clinical studies involving human subjects as well as non-human subject research with benefit to the Ministry Of Health.
- The scientific committee will review and reserve the right to decide on acceptance of abstracts for poster presentation.

2. SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All abstracts must be submitted via email to the secretariat. Hardcopy submissions will not be accepted.
- Abstracts must be submitted by 10th August 2018. Late submission or incomplete abstracts will not be accepted.
- The secretariat will notify participants regarding the results of their submission by 27th September 2018.

3. ABSTRACT FORMAT

- The structured abstract should not exceed 300 words and include the following sections: Introduction, methodology, result and discussion / conclusion. Do not include graphs, tables, illustrations, references or acknowledgment in the abstract.
- Use Arial font, regular size 12.
- Author(s) name(s) must be written in full. Do not include professional title or degrees. List institutional affiliation, state and country.

4. BEST INVESTIGATOR AWARD

- Three abstracts with the highest grades will be shortlisted for oral presentation. The winner will be given the best investigator award.
- First prizes winner will be awarded RM500, with RM300 and RM150 for second and third place.

5. BEST POSTER AWARDS

- The prizes for best poster presentation will be given to top three in each category (Allied Health and professional group).
- Prizes are RM300 for first place, Rm200 for second place and RM100 for third place.
- Each winner will receive a certificate of achievement. Judges' decisions are final no correspondence will be entertained.

6. POSTER DISPLAY AND PRESENTATION

- Poster must be in the following format : Vertical A1 size (594 MM width x 841 MM height)
- Participants are responsible for printing of poster and for materials to put up the posters on the poster panel.
- Participants are encouraged to provide handouts for judges and visitors during presentation session.
- Posters are to be put up at the designated poster panels between 8 am, 29th Oct 2018 and 2 pm, 2nd Nov 2018.

ABSTRACT:

STRUCTURED ABSTRACT FORM

- Please limit introduction, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion to a maximum of 300 words.

Poster Title:

- Title summarizes abstract
- Abstract title must be in Title Case, e.g. "Cardiovascular Problems".

Authors & Affiliations:

- List authors and affiliations

Introduction:

- Outlines the clinical problem
- Define abbreviations, for example: **Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS)**
- Introduction ends with hypothesis or statement of purpose, for example: '**our clinical observations suggested the hypothesis that seborrheic dermatitis is an under recognised but common skin manifestation of AIDS that has important, short term prognostic significance**'.

Methodology:

- Describes study design, setting, sample and control selection, outcome measures and statistical analysis.
- Statistical analysis is described, for example: '**Comparisons were analysed with chi square and relative risk calculations**'.

Results:

- Results begin with a description of the study sample, controls and exclusions.
- List frequencies of the most common outcomes
- Describe comparisons of outcomes between groups

Discussion/Conclusion

- Summarize conclusions and implications of study.

Word Count:

- State your total word count, including introduction, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion.
